# Queen Elizabeth II 1926 - 2022

It was with great sadness that Buckingham Palace announced yesterday the death of Her Majesty The Queen.

The long reign of Queen Elizabeth II was marked by her strong sense of duty and her determination to dedicate her life to her throne and to her people. She became for many the one constant point in a rapidly changing world.



On the occasion of her Silver Jubilee, she recalled the pledge she had made on a visit to South Africa 30 years before.

"When I was 21, I pledged my life to the service of our people and I asked for God's help to make good that vow. Although that vow was made in my salad days, when I was green in judgement, I do not regret, or retract, one word of it."

The Department for Education has advised schools to remain open during the period of national mourning that will continue until the end of the State Funeral.

Action songs before home time.


