Bird boxes for Witley School

On Monday, we received x10 birdboxes for our school. These boxes were completely free and built by Tom, a Scottish Borders primary school teacher, from sustainably harvested timber grown and milled in the Highlands of Scotland.





To give you a little background about Tom and the Surrey Primary Schools Birdbox Project, Tom has, over the last few years, been building and delivering birdboxes to primary schools all across Scotland and now England. During that time, he has built and delivered some 9,000 boxes.

The idea is to promote engagement between young people and the wild world around them by putting nature directly into

their eyeline at an early age. We'll be putting the boxes up around the school very soon.

REMINDER - Flu vaccinations






