Summer Holidays 2026 Information from Surrey County Council: Support for families during the summer school holidays

A range of support remains available for families over the summer and we've compiled details of some of these schemes including affordable days out, supermarket discount schemes and food banks here: [Support with food costs for families - Surrey County Council](#).

The Holiday Activity and Food Programme - known as [Club4](#) in Surrey - is also available to families in receipt of Targeted FSM, with bookings going live on Tuesday 30 June.

We are awaiting further details on the UK Government's recently announced Great British Summer Savings scheme, which is expected to include free bus travel for children and targeted food tariff reductions.
