Friends of Witley School Chair's AGM Reprt October 2024

I speak on behalf of Sam and Tiff when I say we really enjoyed our first year back last year and the addition of Emily was excellent as she brought so much creative flare to the events. It was great to have Hannah and Katy continuing and we've been a really good team. Huge thanks to Hannah and Katy who have taken a break this year and will be missed for their big smiles and brilliant, tireless effort. We welcome Anna to the team who is

already proving to be a brilliant addition. This year the team consists of Jo (Chair), Tiff (Treasurer), Sam (Secretary), Emily and Anna.

The big fundraisers last year were the cake raffle £2054, Christmas Grotto £1123, Sponsored Dino Run £1200 and the Summer Social 31344. Our efforts overall raised £8872. And we spent £6273 on the school as well as charity donations.

We hoped to develop a real feeling of camaraderie and community and we felt that in all our events last year, with lots of helpers and good turn outs. We want to keep this going throughout our time on the FWS team.

We are all feeling really enthusiastic and up for a big year of fund raising with the focus very much on joy for the kids and investment for the school that will make a noticeable difference to the children's time there.

There are many fund raising events coming up, the Cake Raffle is in its 8th week and is set to raise over £2000 again and we ran a successful Ice Cream Stall which was a freebie from FWS. November is a big month. The inaugural Bingo night is our imminent first big event, followed by The Disco and our first ever Christmas Wreath Making. We have still to announce our Christmas event and this was discussed at the AGM. We have a Christmas Entertainer coming on the last day of term and then in 2025 there will be Krispy Kremes, World Book Day Workshops, Science Displays, Easter Egg Hunts, an all new Barn Dance, Colour Run, Fruity Fridays, Sponsored all day Danceathon, Cricket Witley v Hambledon, the Leavers Dinner and The Summer Social.

As mentioned in our welcome letter we want to provide fun and meaningful experiences for the kids as much as we want to fundraise. So theatre groups, world book day events, Christmas entertainers, Christmas presents, Ice creams, Easter egg hunts and Science displays are all part of those experiences and are our treat. And then events such as the Colour Run & Leavers dinner are about fun whilst covering costs! And the big events hopefully provide all of the above whilst also raising plenty of money for the school. There are between 6 and 8 events each term which should provide nicely spaced interest and fun for everyone and hopefully a steady stream of fund raising.

We are asking the school to come to us with projects they need money for and we are very aware that we haven't yet spent the money we intended to at the end of last term. We want to spend it on things that will enhance the kid's experience at Witley and improve the environment for everyone. If anyone has any ideas or suggestions please get in touch. We will continue to communicate to the parents how we spend the money, regularly and clearly. The School provides a regular Amazon Wishlist which FWS pay for.

We didn't run a DIY day last year so it would be good to get that organised this year in the warmer months. When we ran it previously there was a wonderful sense of community and common goals and seeing the results of our work immediately was gratifying.

Of course volunteers are a vital part of our work. We take the events as our responsibility but they are only ever a big success when parents get involved. We will need volunteers throughout the year. Even a half hour commitment to shifting some tables, blowing up balloons or manning a stall makes a huge difference. We will ask for volunteers in advance of the events and we ask that give any time you can.

So big thanks to the outgoing team members and parents from 2023/24 and huge thanks in advance to everyone who comes on the ride with us this year and helps make 24/25 a massive success.


